Kevin Espirito transformed Microsoft's employee giving program. As the Senior Manager of Employee Community Engagement, he oversaw global initiatives for employee giving, volunteering, annual campaigns, and Microsoft's matching gift program.

Under his leadership, Microsoft increased annual donations from \$84 million to \$117 million and surpassed \$1 billion in total employee contributions.

Starting at Microsoft in 1999, Kevin held roles in OEM, Partner Sales & Marketing, and IT before shifting to the Citizenship group, later part of Microsoft Philanthropies. His leadership cultivated a culture of philanthropy and community service across the company.

Since leaving Microsoft in 2015, Kevin has founded several nonprofits and continues to drive social impact through his volunteer work. He lives in Indianapolis and is currently the lead of Microsoft Alumni Network's Indiana club.
